Amendment of Rule 6 of the Rules for the Board of Law Examiners

On order of the Court, notice of the proposed changes and an opportunity for comment in writing and at a public hearing having been provided, and consideration having been given to the comments received, the following amendment of Rule 6 of the Rules for the Board of Law Examiners is adopted, effective immediately.

[The present language is amended as indicated below by underlining for new text and strikeover for text that has been deleted.]

Rule 6 Fees

The fees are: an application for examination, \$340 \$300 and an additional fee for the late filing of an application or transfer of an application for examination, \$100; an application for reexamination for examination, \$240 \$200; an application for recertification, \$200; an application for admission without examination, \$600 plus the requisite fee for the National Conference of Bar Examiners' report. Checks must be payable to the State of Michigan.

Staff Comment: The amendment of Rule 6 of the Rules for the Board of Law Examiners increases the fees for application for the bar examination from \$300 to \$340, and for reexamination from \$200 to \$240. The increase in fees allows for the implementation of the change in policy regarding grading Michigan bar examinations that is reflected in the attached notice.

The staff comment is not an authoritative construction by the Court.
